UPCOMING ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF QUEBEC NATIVE WOMEN

Kahnawake, November 20, 2024 – Quebec Native Women (QNW) announces that the election for the position of president will be held during the Annual General Assembly (AGA), which will bring together its members, on November 30 and December 1, 2024, in Quebec City.

This event will determine, through an election, the leader who will guide the organization in its mission to promote the rights and well-being of First Nations women throughout Quebec for the next four years.

The Election President has confirmed that two women who have submitted their candidacies are eligible for the position of president: the outgoing president, Ms. Marjolaine Étienne, and Ms. Annick Flamand, currently director of the private residence – Elder's home of Manawan.

The candidates for this prestigious position will have the opportunity to present their visions, priorities, and plans for the future of QNW during the AGA. Quebec Native Women strongly encourages all designated representatives to participate in this essential democratic process. Your voice matters, and your vote will help shape the future of our organization and community.
